



Frequently asked Questions

Our goal at Tri-Sate Speedway is to provide you with an evening of the most competitive and exciting racing possible, at a facility we can all be proud of. The following is some information that can help make your visit more enjoyable.

What time do the races start? Grandstand gates open at 4:30pm the Pit Gate opens at 3:30 pm and racing begins at 6:00pm. These times are for our Saturday night race, if on another night be sure to check our start time.

How much to get in? Grandstand admission for Adults - \$10, Kids 6-12 \$5, 5-under is free. Pit admission for Adults - \$30, Kids 12-under - \$20. Please note, on special race nights, admission prices might change, so please check our website or call us at 918-436-2914 for more information.

Do drivers have to use a RACEIVER? We strongly recommend all drivers purchase a RACEIVER. They are very inexpensive considering the money that they can save a driver from a wreck. As we say, \$100 now or \$1,000 later.

Can I bring a lawn chair? We ask that if you do bring a lawn chair or bleacher seat, that the legs be the shorten type so as not to obstruct the view of the people behind you.

Can I bring my own food or cooler? We do not allow any outside food or drink to be brought in the racing complex. If you require special needs (food or drink), please contact the management prior to the races at 918-436-2914. Of course, baby food and baby bottle are acceptable. Any outside food or drink we will ask you to dispose of it, so please do not be offended.

Do you have reserve seating? We do not have reserved seating, so we recommend to get to the track early. Grab you one of our famous hamburgers a coke and watch the festivities.

Can I bring my dog? You are allowed to bring your dog to the races; please make sure that fido stays on a leash and if he needs to relieve himself, please take him to the parking area.

Can I bring my RV / camp out / or stay the night? Yes, you are allowed to campout, park your RV and stay the night if you would like. We do ask that you not have any open fires or fireworks during your stay. Feel free to park or camp in the parking area, we just ask that you pick up all your trash and clean up any mess you might leave us.

Rainout / Rain check policy - In the event of inclement weather we will post on our website, on our answering machine and on racing forums prior to the races. In the event that racing has started, and in the

opinion of the track officials, the inclement weather is sufficient to cancel the remainder of the racing events the show will be considered a complete show if we have reached intermission or the Heat races are complete. If the halfway point in the program has not been completed, rain checks (tickets to races) will be issued good for an upcoming race. NO REFUNDS will be given. If you purchased a pit pass, your armband is your rain check and your responsibility. We are not responsible for loss or theft of your rain check. If you choose to use your rain check at an event with a higher admission you will have to pay the difference.

Are you Handicap Friendly? Yes, we have handicap parking on the fence of the grandstand parking area. If you are in a wheelchair, you can park your wheelchair in front of the main grandstands. We have handicap restrooms and you can easily access our concession stand and pro shop without incident.

How big is the track? Tri-Sate Speedway is a 3/8th mile dirt race track. It is a banked track, about 25° banking.

Where is your track located? We are off of HWY 9 / 112 / 271 / I-540, just a few minutes south of Fort Smith, Arkansas and about 10 miles north of Spiro, Oklahoma. If you're using GPS, our physical address is 2374 W Race Track Rd in Pocola, OK, 74902. And a stones throw from the Arkansas / Oklahoma State line!

Where can I purchase TSS Gear? We have a pro-shop under the grandstands. So check us out and grab some of our gear.

What classes of cars do you race? We race four divisions of Stock Cars weekly and two divisions of Modified. Sprints and Late Models visit frequently, check out our schedule on our website for more information.
